Program Components

Opening Retreat: Builds self-reflection, introduces core tools, and sets the tone for immersive learning.

Leadership Forums: Collaborative sessions on living infrastructure, narrative frameworks, and systems navigation for climate resilience. Held across Los Angeles County for diverse, place-based learning.

Cohort Project: Team-led exploration of real climate challenges, applying skills in a live setting.

Closing Symposium: Facilitated reflection, networking, and shared insights to extend learning beyond the program.
